JOHN MORRIS, *a Dominican priest and professor at the College of St. Mary in Moraga, CA, will give an overview of Catholic teaching on social justice, highlighting the Catholic Church's teaching about labor unions and immigration.*

RAMON RAMIREZ, *Co-founder and President of Pineros y Campesinos Unidos del Noroeste (PCUN), will describe the lives of Northwest farmworkers, their current labor concerns, and the role of the union. He will also assess the future of the union and leadership development among the members.*

After this presentation, Ramirez and Morris will discuss their ideas with the audience, and Javier Lara, the union's Community Organizer, will provide information about the farmworkers' new leadership training center, under construction in Woodburn.
